

SAFETY

The Board considers the safety and well-being of students, employees and the general public of prime importance in all school activities. Consequently, we must strive to provide a safe school environment by ensuring that:

1. Students and employees are provided all reasonable safeguards to insure safe educational and working conditions.
2. Institutional material, equipment, tools, machines and vehicles are maintained in good working condition.
3. Any unsafe condition or practices noticed by an employee will be corrected and/or reported to the Superintendent.
4. We continue to study and develop safe work methods and train students and employees in these methods.
5. We continue to comply with federal, state and local laws regarding accident prevention.

The Board charges the Superintendent with assuring that safety procedures for students, staff, and the general public are developed and updated as necessary. The Superintendent is further responsible for assuring that these procedures are reviewed annually with staff and students.
