

### EXPOSURE CONTROL PLAN

The Sharon Springs Central School District is committed to provide a safe and healthful work environment. In pursuit of this endeavor, the following Exposure Control Plan (ECP) is provided to eliminate or minimize occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens in accordance with OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standard, Title 29 Code of Federal Regulations 1910.1030.

The Exposure Control Plan is a key document to assist our School District/BOCES in implementing and ensuring compliance with the Bloodborne Pathogens Standard 29 CFR Part 1910.1030, thereby protecting our employees. This Exposure Control Plan includes:

- I. Employee exposure determination
- II. The procedures for evaluating the circumstances surrounding an exposure incident, and
- III. The schedule and method for implementing the specific sections of the standard, including:
  - >>Methods of Compliance
  - >>Hepatitis B vaccination and post-exposure follow up
  - >>Training and communication of hazards to employees
  - >>Recordkeeping
