The individual use of iPads is a way to empower students to maximize their full potential and to prepare them for college and the workplace.

With the distribution of iPads to students in grades 7-12, we have embarked into new territories of learning and individual responsibilities. This includes maintaining the proper balance between fulfilling academic requirements and recreational use of the iPad for purposes such as use of social media sites as Facebook and Twitter, to name just a few.

The district would like to expand this access, after school hours, for those students that have parental permission and are meeting their academic responsibilities. This access can be rescinded, if deemed necessary, during the course of the school year. Again, the iPads remain district property, and students do not have an expectation of privacy on the devices. Furthermore, any irreplaceable files or information should be backed up and stored in another location. For safety reasons, students are to have their iPads off in the hallway, left in the building during fire drills, and left in the student's locker during assemblies.
