Halloween Costumes

I would like to invite parents, family members, and community members to our annual Halloween Parade on **Tuesday** the 31st. The parade will begin promptly at 2:10 pm. Students will be marching around the first floor of the building and outdoors (weather permitting). Please remember that costumes must be appropriate for a school setting, and not involve excessive blood, gore, or weapons. In addition, costumes need to follow the basic requirements of the Code of Conduct Dress Code and not be “revealing” or “suggestive” in nature. In addition, Middle and High School costumes must be able to be worn in such a manner that it will not distract or disrupt the educational activities that are otherwise planned for the day. **Again this year**, “scary clown/ creepy clown” masks and costumes will **not** be allowed to be worn or possessed on school grounds.

K-8 After School Program
