

QUALIFICATIONS FOR VOTING

A person shall be entitled to vote at any school meeting for the election of school district officers, and upon all other matters which may be brought before such meeting who is:

- I. A citizen of the United States.
2. Eighteen years of age.
3. A resident within the district for a period of thirty (30) days or more preceding the meeting.
4. No person shall have the right to register for or vote at any school meeting or election who would not be qualified to register for or vote at an election in accordance with the provisions of Section 5-106 of the Education Law. This includes most convicted felons and those adjudged mentally incompetent by a court.
